

COMPLEMENTARY AND ALTERNATIVE MEDICINE (CAMP) eLEARNING and ONLINE TRAINING PROGRAM

The Complementary and Alternative Medicine Practitioner (CAMP) program combines studies in basic health science courses (anatomy, physiology, kinesiology, pathology and biomedicine) with core courses in complementary, alternative, natural, homeopathic, holistic, herbal, and nutritional

medicine, along with bodywork, hydrotherapy, and exercise therapy. CAMP's work with clients on personal wellness, health promotion, illness prevention, and in cooperation with other health care professionals for the care of patients with medically diagnosed illness and disease.

CAMP's work in hospitals, medical clinics, holistic health care centers, chiropractic offices, medical health spas, and as private practice consultants.



Students that complete the Complementary and Alternative Medicine Program receive a diploma from the Blue Heron Academy of Healing Arts and Sciences, a state licensed post-secondary school. The Complementary and Alternative Practitioner Program is licensed by the state of Michigan.

Students must complete all the following courses:

HEALTH SCIENCE COURSES –

- a) Science of the Human Body (Anatomy and Physiology)
- b) Body in Motion (Kinesiology)
- c) Pathology and Natural Medicine (Pathology)
- d) Biomedicine for Health Science Professionals

NATURAL HEALTH CARE COURSES -

- a) Holistic Health Consultant
- b) Massage Therapy Lymphedema
- c) Clinical Nutrition
- d) Herbal Medicine
- e) Personal Trainer
- f) Acupressure and Chinese Massage

The CAMP training program educational package also includes the General Manual Therapy Protocol DVD to enhance the students training in bodywork. Also included is the Serenity Zone three step relaxation audio CD program for stress management.
